

EMMA (European Masters of Modern Art)

The 'European Masters of Modern Art' was an exhibition which was founded by the Franz Drapela Foundation. His wish was that this exhibition should take place every two years in the winner's country. Each European Country would be represented by 2 artists. Jette van der Lende was one selected by Frans Drapela and his son Eric to represent Norway. The 1st 'European Masters of Modern Art' took place in the Watercastle of Burgau, in Styria, from April 14th 2007 until may 6th 2007.
